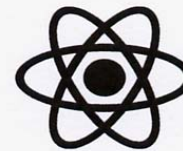

GSDL March Sheep Herding Trials

After losing the use of sheep at the Bill Spilstead Complex for Canine Affairs at Erskine Park we decided to hold our March Sheep Herding trials at the property of Pat Smith in Lakesland. It took several months of hard work and some uncertainty, but finally the property was ready to hold the trials.

The sheep, accustomed to training with our breed, seemed to perform better with the bigger dogs, but there were still several Border Collies, Australian Shepherds, Cattle Dogs and a Bearded Collie who performed well.

Sheep herding is still fairly new for a lot of our members with our first trial being held last year in March and another in conjunction with last year's National.

Nevertheless, it was great to see so many German Shepherds (a total of 25 for the weekend) and their handlers entered, including mostly members of the Campbelltown Branch, as well as former GSDL Secretary Andrew Thor and his dog Sonja (Narathor Finesse) who passed the Herding Instinct test after only being on the sheep once before.

There were also several GSD owners from country NSW and Victoria who travelled far and wide to compete. Many of the GSDs were only up to test classes at this stage, with a total of 16 German Shepherds qualifying in their tests over the weekend.

We did, however, have a few GSDs entered in trial classes but unfortunately none made it through due to nerves or lack of concentration of the handlers.

A BBQ and refreshments were available, and the weather could not have been better. The atmosphere was relaxed and everyone enjoyed each other's company, with no breed discrimination between the competitors.

It was fantastic to see members of the Herding community rallying together to support each other, as well as commiserate and offer encouragement to those who unfortunately didn't make it through on the day.

On the whole it was a great weekend, and hopefully we'll have even more members of the GSDL competing in our trials in May. It's really amazing watching our dogs do what they were originally bred for.

"Titan" Police Dog 33



On Wednesday 12th March Dogs N.S.W. held a tree planting ceremony at the Bill Spilstead Complex for Canine Affairs Erskine Park to honour Police Dog Titan who was killed in the line of duty during a siege at Seven Hills in Sydney 23rd December 2004.

Titan was the first N.S.W. Police Dog to be killed by an offender. Senior Constable Sean McDowell, Titan's handler attended the ceremony.

Officiating were the President of Dogs N.S.W. Mr. Frank Pieterse, Promotions Officer Kerry Cristophi of Dogs N.S.W. Vice President of the G.S.D.L. Mr. Terry Jarvis who met Titan as a puppy represented the German shepherd fraternity.

Also present were his Breeder, Christine Anderson and League member Lesley MacGillivray who was there when Titan was whelped.

Dogs N.S.W had a granite plaque made in memory of Titan and this was set on a colourful sandstone slab in the small garden lawn in the front of Dogs N.S.W main building entrance.

Any one who visits should stop and take a look if you have not already seen it and reflect on what our wonderful German Shepherd dogs do and do willingly for us in all facets of things.

The German Shepherd Dog League thanks Dogs NSW. on an outstanding effort in producing this Plaque and the tree in memory of Titan in a so prominent place for all to see.
