To all member Clubs.

As you are aware the matter of acceptance of computer radiography generated images (digital x-rays) was discussed at some length at the NBC meeting held in Melbourne in July.

The meeting agreed that I should as National Breed Commission Chairman investigate this issue to ensure that the GSDCA readers are able to view and score these images with similar accuracy.

Over the past month I have spoken to all of the GSDCA readers, and the National Breed Commission Executive have come to the conclusion detailed in the attached correspondence.

It would seem at the moment, the two States where Veterinarians are taking the majority of Digital X-rays are New South Wales and Tasmania.

The National Breed Commission Executive request that it is imperative that the members are advised of the GSDCA requirements regarding this issue.

We suggest that the x-ray requirements are placed on all Club websites as well as the GSDCA Website as a matter of urgency.

This matter has not been dealt with lightly by the National Breed Commission Executive and we have undertaken to ensure that the criteria is fair to all.

A copy of this correspondence will be forwarded to all State HD and ED Registrars for their information and request that a copy of the correspondence titled X-rays requirements be issued with all GSDCA Hip Dysplasia and Elbow Dysplasia Application forms as from 1st September 2008.

POLICE DOG MEMORIAL

Wollondilly Shire Councillor Helen Kuiper recently moved a Police Dog Memorial be established in the Shire in recognition of PD Carts and PD Titan, brothers who were stabbed to death. Titan was killed during a siege on 23.12.2004 and Carts killed at Corrimal on 9.12.07.

Re: Acceptance of Computer Radiography Generated Images (Digital X-rays)

At the 2008 National Breed Commission Meeting held in July in Melbourne the subject of acceptance of digital x-rays was discussed at some length.

The meeting agreed that all member Club Hip Dysplasia Registrars as well as Dr Lavelle, Prof Wyburn and Dr Allan be advised of the following decision.

- Suspend the acceptance of digital x-rays at this point in time.
- NBC Chair to contact GSDCA readers to implement programmes to view these images to provide similar accuracy.
- Re-adjust the GSDCA requirement for acceptance of x-ray plates and computer radiography generated images (digital x-rays) submitted for the GSDCA Hip and Elbow Dysplasia Control Scheme and circulate to all member clubs.

Since the National Breed Commission Meeting, I have spoken to the readers and I wish to advise the member Clubs that all readers *now have in place a programme to assess digital x-rays with similar accuracy*.

Following these discussions, it is the opinion of the National Breed Commission Executive that computer radiography generated images (digital x-rays) can be accepted by the GSDCA Hip and Elbow Dysplasia Control Scheme on the proviso that they meet the GSDCA requirements, are of a high quality and saved in a **DICOM format** (i.e. .dcm extension)

Images saved and forwarded **in any other format** will not be accepted for reading and will be returned by the reader to Doug West, the GSDCA Hip and Elbow Dysplasia Control Scheme Registrar. The Registrar shall then contact the Veterinarian/Owner advising them of the situation.

At this stage the number of veterinarians using computer radiography generated images (digital x-rays) is in the minority, but it is expected that this will change in the very near future.

The GSDCA Executive needs to ensure that the integrity of the GSDCA Hip and Elbow Dysplasia Control Scheme stays intact, by developing a criteria that is fair to all.

From my research, it would appear that there is agreement that computer generated images saved in the DICOM format are accepted in a court of law without query.

Please find attached the revised criteria for acceptance of x-ray plates and computer radiography generated images (digital x-rays) submitted to the GSDCA Hip and Elbow Dysplasia Control Scheme.

It is the opinion of the NBC Executive that the criteria become effective as from 1st September 2008 and will be ratified at the 2009 GSDCA Annual General Meeting to be held in Melbourne in February.

ACCEPTANCE OF X-RAYS PLATES AND COMPUTER RADIOGRAPHY GENERATED IMAGES (DIGITAL X-RAYS) SUBMITTED TO THE GSDCA HIP DYSPLASIA AND ELBOW DYSPLASIA CONTROL SCHEME

The x-ray plates/digital x-rays submitted for assessment in the GSDCA Hip Dysplasia and Elbow Dysplasia Control Scheme are to be as follows; -

The radiographs **SHALL** be identified **RADIOGRAPHICALLY** with all of the following:

- a) the dog's GSDCA tattoo number
- b) the date
- c) right or left marker
- d) the dog's name
- e) State Contract Number

<u>Please note</u>: Incorrectly labeled x-rays and/or x-rays of poor quality (plates or digital) **will not** be accepted for reading and shall be returned by the reader to the GSDCA Hip and Elbow Dysplasia Control Scheme Registrar. The Registrar shall then contact the Veterinarian/Owner advising them of the situation.

Computer Radiography Generated Images (Digital X-rays)

For computer radiography generated images (digital x-rays) to be accepted by the GSDCA Hip Dysplasia and Elbow Dysplasia Control Scheme, the images must be of a **high quality** and saved as **DICOM Images.** (i.e. .dcm extension)

Images saved and forwarded in any other format will not be accepted for reading and shall be returned by the reader to the GSDCA Hip Dysplasia and Elbow Dysplasia Control Scheme Registrar. The Registrar shall then contact the Veterinarian/Owner advising them of the situation.

POSITION OF ANIMALS FOR X-RAYING HD x-ray

One view of the dog's pelvis is to be taken under general anaesthesia. A high quality radiograph/digital radiograph is required and any incorrectly exposed or poorly positioned films will not be read but returned for re-x-raying. The radiograph should be repeated at the veterinarian's expense.

View: Extended Ventro-Dorsal pelvis

No other view will be accepted for assessment.

The radiograph should cover an area from the iliac crest to the stifle joint. The femora should be parallel to each other and the stifles rotated inward so that the patellae lie in the centre of the trochleae of the femora, Care should be taken to ensure that the pelvis is square and the femora are parallel to the cassette.

Elbow X-ray:

A fully flexed lateral view taken from the medial to the lateral.

The onus is on the Veterinarian to ensure the animal complies with the requirements of the GSDCA schemes.

Note: No attached labels are acceptable.
