More from the news about the German shepherd dragged 30m out of car door

The woman, who's German shepherd was dragged 30 metres down a street, after its tail was slammed in her van door, has been charged with animal neglect.

On April 26 police were called to Mascot in Sydney's south where neighbours allegedly saw the 64-year-old woman slam the dog's tail in a side door of her Toyota van, then drive up the street.

When police arrived, they found the dog with grazes on its mouth, face, back legs and tail.

It appeared underweight, with its ribs easily visible.

Officers seized the animal from the woman and took it to the RSPCA.

Police say veterinary checks have found the two-year-old dog suffered "numerous medical problems".

The woman was arrested on yesterday and charged with failing to provide veterinary treatment to an animal in her care.

"Police are awaiting further information in relation to the initial incident in April before considering any further action against the woman," they said.



Registration of White Swiss Shepherd Dogs

Now that the ANKC has recognised the White Swiss Shepherd Dog it is essential that all Members and Data Entry personnel understand that this recognition does not apply to White German Shepherd Dogs or White Swiss Shepherd Dogs that do not have a complete Export certificate with all dogs in the background registered as White Swiss Shepherd Dogs.

In accordance with ANKC regulations White German Shepherd Dogs **cannot** be registered as White Swiss Shepherd Dogs.

Imported White Swiss Shepherd Dogs MUST have all dogs in the background of their Import Certificate registered as White Swiss Shepherd Dogs in compliance with ANKC Regulation Part 6 Clause 3.4.

If one or more of the dogs in the background of the Import Certificate is registered as a German Shepherd Dogs the dog cannot be registered on the ANKC Main or Limited Register.

All White Swiss Shepherd Dogs imported into Australia MUST comply with ANKC Regulation Part 6 Clauses 3 and all its sub-clauses.

If in the future people wish to have White German Shepherd Dogs recognised they will have to do so as a completely new separate breed with a **NEW** Name, and comply with ANKC Regulation Part 6 Clause 9.2 and all its sub – clauses.

The only dogs born in Australia that can be registered as White Swiss Shepherd Dogs are those dogs resulting from the mating

of two imported White Swiss Shepherd Dogs that have been registered with the ANKC on their Main Stud register, or further generations resulting from such matings.

Squatter, dog homeless after fire in Dolls Point July 07, 2009

A Squatter and his dog escaped uninjured after the derelict home he had been occupying was engulfed in flames in Sydney's south last night.

The single level brick and tile house was basically destroyed by the fire on the Grand Parade, Dolls Point, which started about 10:40pm.

The fire was contained quickly and there was no damage to neighbouring properties.

According to local residents the house had been unoccupied for about two years, and a squatter and his German shepherd had stayed there for some time.

A police spokeswoman said the man and his German shepherd were out the back of the house when the fire started, and escaped uninjured

German shepherd puppies, Cloned from hero 9/11 search and rescue dog, July 07, 2009

The cost to clone is \$155,000. But not everyone can afford that price tag, and so BioArts announced its Golden Clone Giveaway, through which one winner would be chosen to have their dog cloned free of charge.

The contest winner, it turns out, is a retired Canadian police officer who now lives in Los Angeles. The owner wrote movingly about his dog Trakr, a German shepherd who participated in search-and-rescue efforts at the World Trade Center in the aftermath of 9/11.

He and Trakr eventually located the last survivor found after the attacks. "Once in a lifetime, a dog comes along that not only captures the hearts of all he touches but also plays a pivotal role in history," was the beginning of the essay about Trakr, who died at age 16 in April.

In the years before his death, Trakr had lost the use of his rear legs due to a degenerative neurological disorder that some experts believe was related to exposure to toxic smoke at Ground Zero.

Trakr's story "blew us away," BioArts CEO said of the contest's selection process. "His many remarkable capabilities were proven beyond all doubt in our nation's darkest hour -- and we view the work of cloning him as a great honor." A few days ago, Trakrs owner was presented with five cloned mini-Trakrs.

The pups (Trustt, Solace, Valor, Prodigy and Deja vu) will be trained to respond to emergency situations as "Team Trakr,"

The American Society for the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals issued a statement on the controversial practice of animal cloning: "Our current knowledge of animal cloning indicates that there are important welfare concerns at issue.

Reports on the health and condition of mammalian animals produced by cloning have indicated a variety of anatomical and physiological problems."

I first became aware of the existence of the Save A Shepherd Rescue Group in August, 2008 when a 6 year old GSD female sired by our Iwan son was surrendered at Hawkesbury Pound. I recognized the dog as possibly having been bred by a friend because of her unusual call name ,age, appearance etc

Poor Java had been surrendered because the male owner had remarried and the new wife did not like dogs, so this unfortunate girl was sent to death row.

Surrendered dogs, under law, do not have to be kept by pounds for the mandatory 7 days or in the case of microchipped dogs 14 days but may be and often are euthanased within a 24 hour period.

I noticed on the Hawkesbury Pound internet site that Java had been rescued by a group called Save A Shepherd. I obtained their details and made contact to advise that I could provide details of this girl's background, breeding, date of birth etc which might assist her chances of finding a new home.

That is how my relationship with Tanya and Andrew Evans of Save a Shepherd started

Java now Ava found a wonderful, loving home with Dawn the following month. Dawn and I have become great friends and I get regular updates on Ava and her escapades on the beach and am advised that Ava is a real "man magnet"

I assist Tanya and Andrew in identifying the breeders of tattooed dogs that find themselves abandoned in pounds . I then contact the breeder to advise them of the situation and obtain any information that may assist in rehoming the dog e.g. breeding , age etc

We understand that in most cases the breeder is not able to take the dog back but they are given the option before the dog is listed for rehoming.

We should bear in mind that although some dogs have been tattooed, due to the age of the dog, the tattoo has faded and become illegible and sadly many dogs arrive at the pound with very badly fly bitten ears. In some cases the ears have been eaten down to bloody stumps. Some dogs that come into rescue are not able to be identified

I urge breeders to emphasis to puppy buyers, the importance of spraying the ears of their dog at least twice a week, particularly in the hotter months when flies are more active with Troy Repel X, Value Plus Fly Spray or similar. These products sell for around \$20 and last for ages. Perhaps a small bottle in the Puppy Pack might be an incentive for new owners.

Sadly the majority of dogs rescued from pounds have fly bite to some extent.

Save A Shepherd Rescue Group

Save a Shepherd was founded in July, 2008 and consists of a husband and wife team , Andrew and Tanya Evans. Tanya is Flight Lieutenant is the RAAF and they are based in the ACT.

They keep an active watch on GSDs in pounds from Wagga in the west to the Kurri Kurri pound in the Hunter Region. However the majority of the dogs that they rescue are from Sydney pounds. They have a small number of foster carers but most of the dogs live with them whilst they await their new homes

Tanya and Andrew watch the various pound websites and contact the pound whenever there is a GSD surrendered or not collected by the owners. They then collect the dogs and transport them to their property where they live until a new home is found. The dogs are desexed, vaccinated, microchipped, wormed, and heartwormed and any other vet work that is required is undertaken so that the dogs are fit and healthy before going to their new homes.

The dogs are well socialized with each other and reactions to cats and livestock is tested. They also advise whether the dogs are suitable for a home with children. They make every effort to match dogs to the right home to ensure that the home will be their last. All dogs go on a minimum two week trial and it is only after completion of this trial that ownership of the dog is transferred.

Potential adopters are required to fill out a comprehensive adoption form which asks a number of questions which helps Tanya and Andrew determine whether the home and family environment is suitable for a particular dog. They look to make sure that the property has adequate space and fences, that other animals or people in the home won't provide a source of conflict and that they can provide a lifestyle that is suitable to that particular dog. It is important to Tanya and Andrew that both the dog and the family are happy for the rest of the dog's life

Direct surrenders are taken in occasionally, depending on the amount of room that they have at the time. Wherever possible they would prefer to assist with rehoming the dog direct from its previous home as this prevents the dog having to be relocated several times and allows it to stay in a familiar environment, reducing the stress on the dog.

Tanya and Andrew try to make the lives of the dogs at their home as pleasant as possible. As they have their own house dogs, the rescue dogs are housed in kennels with good sized runs, and have they endeavoured to provide some home comforts by collecting unwanted lounge chairs and sofas for the dogs to relax on The diet is a mix of fresh meat and Coprice.

Todate Save A Shepherd have saved over 100 GSDs from death row, that is 100 dogs in 12 months.

Save A Shepherd would be most grateful for any donations, no matter how small to assist them to save more GSDs that find themselves in the pound. Donations would help to cover the cost of transportation, of collecting the dogs from the pounds, the basic vet

work for each dog and then the cost of more intensive vet treatment that some of the dogs require. They recently rescued a 5 months old pup from Renbury Pound that was unfit for sale due to malnourishment causing his growth plates to close over too early resulting in a deformed leg. The pup required surgery to reopen his plates. Many others come in with bad cases of mange, eye infections, chronic ear infections, growths and all require extra testing and treatment. All the dogs are treated for their complaints and nursed back to health until they are ready for adoption. So if you can help by making a donation the GSDs would be most grateful.
