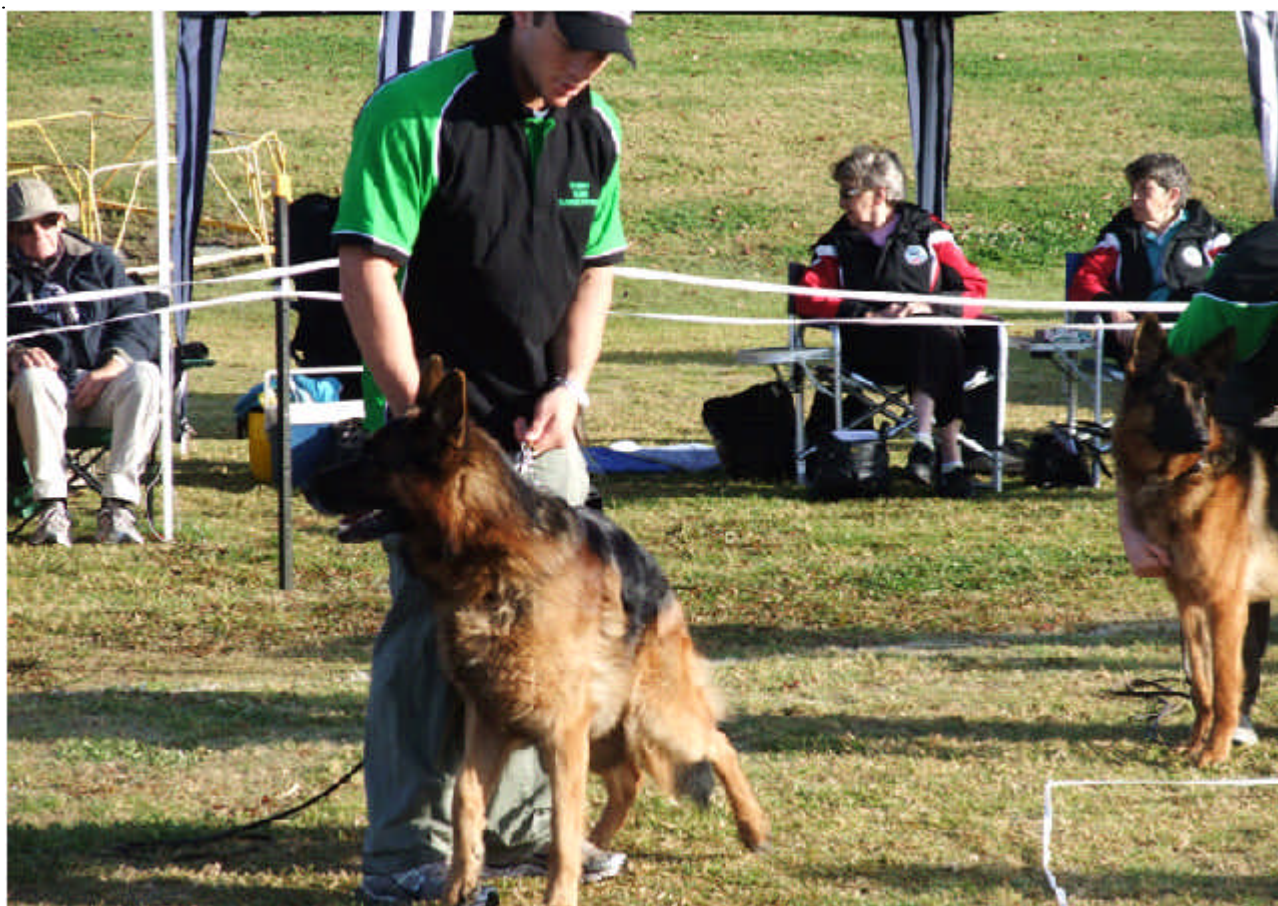

I began judging more than forty years ago, gaining my championship licence in two groups, and have enjoyed judging in most parts of New Zealand. I got my first German Shepherd Dog in 1978, the same year the German Shepherd Dog Advisory Council of NZ was officially recognised; some years later, having begun to judge specialty German Shepherd shows, it was a natural progression to become a surveyor, a position which, since 1985, I have worked hard at and still find rewarding. I am now South Island vice president of the GSDAC. Sadly, NZ has only held two Main Breed shows - 1995 and 1997, both of which I was involved with as an assessor. I enjoy helping run both all breed and specialty shows, often as stenographer at the specialties, and play an active part in the local obedience club. My breeding experience has been somewhat limited, due to not wishing to keep more than a few dogs at a time and being a tad unlucky with the beautiful bitches I have owned, but been unable to breed from. At home I have three GSDs who live in the house and, living rurally, also enjoy the wide open spaces of river and farmland. The next few years will see more litters now that I finally have a worthy brood bitch. In my earlier years I was employed in banking for many years; I took a change of direction in 1987, gained my Vet Nursing ticket and began a career as a vet nurse. This was interrupted by the birth of our daughter Laura, now 21, after which I studied at Massey University and graduated with a Teachers Aide certificate in 2001 and since then have been employed as teacher aide, specialising in working with deaf children.

I believe we live in tough times, and this is reflected in less people being involved with their hobbies - so we need more than ever to strive together to protect our beloved breed. We are very lucky in NZ to have Australian importers and breeders close by, and I admire the progress made in both countries. This is my first specialist appointment outside of New Zealand, so I wish to take this opportunity to sincerely thank the GSDL for the privilege, and wish everyone a very happy weekend of showing.

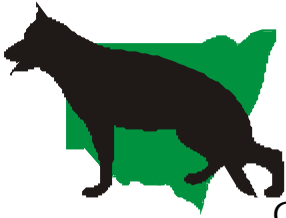

## *Common Non-Toxic Items Dogs Eat*

Yes, we love our dogs ... but boy can they find creative ways to get into trouble!

In emergency clinic, a large percentage of the calls are about things that the dog has gotten into, and the owner wants to know whether or not to worry.

Chewing on things is a normal part of “puppy hood”, and many times the things our dogs eat are not dangerous. Still, you can expect to see some vomiting and maybe even a little diarrhoea when your dog eats something that is not “food”.

So, before you rush your pooch to the vet, check out this list of non-toxic items that dogs often eat. If your dog chews or eats small amounts of any of the items on this list (and it is a long list), you do NOT have to worry unless the object becomes lodged in the stomach or intestines, causing an obstruction.

Acrylic paint	Magic markers
Ballpoint pens	Mineral oil
Bath oil	Modelling clay
Birth control pills	Newspaper - non-coloured
Bubble bath soaps	Pencils (no longer made of lead)
Candles	Petroleum jelly
Chalk	Play-Doh
Citronella candles	Putty
Cosmetics	Rubber cement
Crayons	Shampoo
Deodorants	Shaving cream
Elmer's glue	Silica gel packets
Fabric softeners	Soap
Glow jewellery	Spackle
Hair conditioner	Suntan lotion
Hand lotion	Superglue
Incense	Teething rings
Indelible markers	Thermometers
Ink	Toothpaste
Lipstick	Water colours

If you have any doubt, always call your vet or local emergency clinic.

By the way, the average cost for treating a dog that has gotten into a toxin is \$342.65. If this would be a difficult expense for you to handle, you really could consider pet insurance. Insurance can pay up to 90% of the expenses.

Most toxins that are ingested are treatable, and given time and treatment many pets do just fine. Pet insurance offers pet owners the ability to do the best for their pet without worrying so much about the costs.
