**GENERAL BUSINESS – EXERCISE AREA FOR DOGS** – Chairman raised the suggestion of the League proposing to Dogs NSW that a separate enclosed area be built around the area of the large rubbish bins at the bottom of the show rings which would be built of chain wire, and pipe, with an area for the dogs to enter and then proceed into another enclosed area where they could be let off their leads to exercise which should be of benefit to those people having problems with their dogs not being able to be let off their leads to relieve themselves.

The League would, with the members approval, approach Dogs NSW with the suggestion that if we get approval they may also wish to contribute to the costs of this.
