Smoking Policy for Dogs NSW

All members of the GSDL are reminded that there is a very strict ruling about smoking on DOGS NSW grounds.

This includes any tobacco related product and E-cigarettes.

Under a duty of care the GSDL will enforce the following DOGS NSW Regulation.

Regulations

Part II show – section 19

- i) Smoking is not permitted in an area 20 metres from any ring in which an exhibition is taking place or 20 metres from any food vendor located on the showground.

This regulation is in line with the Department of Health NSW regulation on smoking – section 6a – smoke free environment act 2000.

Fitness Training for Puppies – part 1

With the future requirements for a “performance” component as a pre-requisite for Breed Survey, some breeders and owners have asked what they can do to get their pups/adults fit and ready for the ZAP or for the Endurance Title (E.T.) offered by ANKC member bodies (e.g. Dogs NSW) or other titles such as CCD.

Fitness training for pups can start basically as soon as they are walking.

But by “fit”, I don’t mean running marathons or developing muscles with work outs! Activities that promote balance, co-ordination, brain development and general life skills will start your puppy off on the right foot.

So what can you do, as a breeder, to get started with your little prospects? Let’s look at the time from 3-7 weeks and the activities we can do to build the platform for further development, with the aim to produce dogs with better brains, healthy bodies and longer healthier lives.

Firstly, a warning. Puppies at this age are in a key time of body and brain development. You never want to wear them out – puppies are not very good at telling you when they are tired or too hot, they tend to just keep going – they are not little adults. Their bones are soft, growth plates are still open, tendons and muscles are undeveloped, they are less coordinated than an adult, rapidly growing and they can overheat very quickly. So we need to stick to activities that are safe for little babies while still giving them a solid foundation to go on with.

Some suggested activities:

- Make sure you warm up your puppy before you start (such as by a few minutes of play) and cool them down afterwards (e.g. by making sure that they are quiet and calmed down, maybe a few minutes of slow walking). Don’t put your puppy away unattended after “exercise” – always stay with them for a while to ensure everything is ok.
- Teach your pup balance and body awareness by having them play on different surfaces and slightly uneven surfaces too (not stairs)
- Handling and grooming of course will also teach your pup that they have back legs and a tail!
- Some human toddler play equipment such as low slides and climbing blocks can be useful play gear for older puppies
- Kiddie pools made into ball pits or filled with plastic bottles can provide heaps of fun while also developing body skills
- Wobble boards, puppy swings and some human equipment such as vibration platforms can be useful for short periods

- Build an enriched puppy play pen for your older pups – toys, games and challenges!
- Play with your puppy – a small amount of tug or retrieval games each day
- Exposure to novel areas and activities, beginning in your house and yard and then expanding outside to puppy safe areas, often with their mum and siblings under your direct control.
- In a litter, try to spend individual time each day with each puppy, especially as they get older and approach the 8 week mark when most of them will be leaving home.

In the next Shepherd News, we will look at our older pups from 8 weeks.

To those that show and trial, this is a gentle reminder that all vests are to be returned after the conclusion of each class.

Only those vests that are required for challenges and run-offs are to be kept until the end of the show.

E.G. – 1st and 2nd place getters for each class.

As of the December show, there will be a crate placed at the entrance to each ring, please place your vest in these at the end of your class.

At the completion of each show or trial, a count will be done and an email will be sent to the exhibitor whose vests are missing.

If the club does not receive the missing vest, a \$10.00 fee will be charged to that exhibitor. This is the cost to replace the vest.

We also require a volunteer that would be willing to wash the vests after each show.

GSDL ZAP Familiarisation Day

On the 10th of November, the club held a ZAP familiarisation day after Breed Survey.

This was not a test, just a day where members could familiarise themselves with the different components and equipment used in a ZAP Character Assessment.

The equipment was laid out and members could take their animals through the different stages of a ZAP Assessment.

15 to 20 members took part in this and it was very well received.

The ages of the dogs ranged from 3 months to 2 years.

Our training co-ordinator Kim Graham, ran through each component with the owners and their animals. Overall the animals did extremely well, with the owners heaping praise and confidence to their charges.

The GSDL will endeavour to hold more of these familiarisation days over the coming year, to help our members understand what is required when the ZAP Assessment comes into force. The GSDCA ZAP official manual will be presented to the AGM in February 2020 for ratification. If this goes ahead, the ZAP will commence as of September 2020.
