Report from the President

Time has slipped by again with not a lot happening within the league due to the Virus, still no training Show or Obedience.

We had a go on a couple of trial nights but danger to handlers and instructors caused us to cancel training until things got a little better but this has not happened as the Instructors had to get too close to the handlers which put them in a precarious position which is not fair to either side of the spectrum.

The floods earlier this year did not help much and also Dogs NSW closed the grounds

We had a Breed Survey with eleven dogs presented on the 22nd August with all animals getting classified suitable for breeding.

We had a Covid19 Officer in place taking names, phone numbers and all relevant details including the taking of temperatures.

While Covid19 continues to give us problems, all Surveys will be conducted under the current setup with no spectators or anyone not connected to the Survey and all participants will be expected to wear face masks and maintain a safe distance to each other and when you are done you should leave the grounds. This will continue until further notice.

Some points from our Secretary

- 1. National News Due to Herr Helmut Buss declining the offer to Judge at the 48th National due to COVID19. We have been given the go ahead to contract Jens Becker Olson to replace Herr Buss. Jens will judge the Stock Coat Males and all Long stock Coats.
- 2. The League have advised National Council that it will run the 48th National in May 2021, if due to COVID19, the national cannot be run in 2021, the League will run the 48th National in May 2022. This will also keep the rotation in place. This will allow South Australia to Run the 50th Anniversary National, which they have already been planning for.
- 3. Membership Renewals are now due. Please remember that all cheques are to be made out to The German Shepherd Dog League of NSW Inc. NOT the GSDL
- 4. The Executive of the German Shepherd Dog League are pleased to announce that the League has donated a sum of \$30000 to DOGS NSW for the upgrade of the lighting towers on the Shepherd rings to LED lighting. This will provide better lighting and will reduce costs and the clubs carbon footprint.
- 5. Until further notice ALL league events will be run under the COVID19 regulations as set down by DOGS NSW.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

If you have even mild symptoms, please stay at home and get tested.

Attendees are encouraged to download the COVID SAFE APP

Entries are restricted to residents of NSW and ACT only.

Entries from exhibitors, who reside in the latest COVID-19 case locations in NSW, within 14 days of the date of the show, will not be accepted.

Visitors shall not be permitted to attend this event. A visitor is deemed to be a person who does not own an exhibit entered in the event or is not a member of the household of an entered exhibitor. **NOTE:** If you are the handler of an exhibit you are part of that exhibit and are included

All persons who are not either Officials or Exhibitors MUST register their attendance at the office.

Entry will only be available through the SHOW MANAGER online entries system - no paper entries.

Failure to adhere to any instruction issued by an Official shall result in the exhibitor being required to immediately leave the grounds and they shall be subject to disciplinary action.

The marked catalogue shall serve as a record of attendees for purposes of contact tracing.

A record of officials and staff present at the event shall be maintained by the Secretary.

Lapel card numbers shall be given to exhibitors. There will be no number bibs used

There shall be NO setting up of any exhibitor equipment prior to 7.00am on the day of the Show.

Gazebos must be spaced a minimum of 1.5 metres apart. Only members of the same household shall share a gazebo.

Exhibitors must vacate the Showground if their exhibit is eliminated and they have no further Exhibit in the show.

PHYSICAL DISTANCING

Total numbers shall not exceed the NSW Government Gazetted COVID-19 Restrictions on Gathering and Movement Order current at the time of the show.

There shall be no congregating or setting up under the ring or building awnings.

Keep a minimum of 1.5metres distance between yourself and other exhibitors. All Venders and Patrons shall adhere to physical distancing rules.

Do not shake hands, hug or kiss as a greeting.

Practise good hygiene by cleaning your hands thoroughly for at least 20 seconds with soap and water, or sanitiser, after visiting a common area, or after blowing your nose, coughing, or sneezing.

No person shall encroach into the Steward's designated safety zone.

Masks may be worn by Officials and Exhibitors but are not compulsory.

Hand sanitiser shall be available; exhibitors are also encouraged to provide their own.

Exhibitors shall avoid touching dogs that are not their responsibility.

Exhibitors and Officials shall not use common pens & pencils or tables and chairs.

Exhibitors shall enter the ring area via the entrance and depart via the exit maintaining physical distancing at all times.

Ring equipment shall be regularly sanitised during the event.

A contract cleaner shall be engaged to maintain hygienic conditions in restrooms.

Exhibitors are requested to be considerate of fellow exhibitors and maintain appropriate

hygiene and physical distancing when visiting restrooms.

JUDGING

Exhibitors shall stand at arm's-length from their exhibit as it is being examined by the Judge.

(This will assist in providing the requisite 1.5 metre physical distancing.)

The exhibitor shall be responsible for mouthing the exhibit.

Judges are encouraged to examine exhibits at arms-length to facilitate physical distancing.

Where there is more than one entry in a class, exhibitors must adhere to physical distancing rules.

Judges must wash/sanitise their hands between each exhibit.

Please adhere to these rules whilst participating in the show.

All members of the GSDL are reminded that there is a very strict ruling about smoking on DOGS NSW grounds.

This includes any tobacco related product and E-cigarettes.

Under a duty of care the GSDL will enforce the following DOGS NSW Regulation.

Regulations

Part II show - section 19

i) Smoking is not permitted in an area 20 metres from any ring in which an exhibition is taking place or 20 metres from any food vendor located on the showground.

This regulation is in line with the Department of Health NSW regulation on smoking – section 6a – smoke free environment act 2000.
